Create stunning floral works in the Japanese tradition. Brighten your home or workspace with inspirational floral art created by you!

This class will introduce you to the philosophies and design concepts which are the basis of this discipline and will also allow you to develop your own technique and style.



Initially you will need a kenzan or spiked base, (available in class for \$12), a cutting implement, a flat, shallow dish such as a casserole dish or similar and



perhaps some pens/pencils and paper for notes and sketches. Purchase and/or bring your own plant materials from your garden.

### Materials:

Fresh flowers and foliage-

(Initial forms will be minimalist, so vary the types and lengths of your stems and don't include too many blooms to start with. Most stems should be long initially – you will cut them to suit your arrangement).

Greater diversity of forms will be progressively introduced during the course.
