The Art of Paper Filigree dates back to Medieval Times when it was practiced in convents to decorate and enhance religious pictures.

Learn a modern version of this fascinating ancient and inexpensive art of rolling and shaping narrow strips of coloured paper to make beautiful designs for your own personalised greeting cards.

A new pattern is supplied for your enjoyment each week.

### **Materials:**

- Quilling Paper in various widths 1.5mm, 3mm, 6mm and 9mm wide. In class we tend to mainly use 1.5mm.
- The standard Quilling Tools are slot Tool – a metal tube with a split down one side
- Needle Tool – a needle with top tip cut off.
- Glue – PVA wood glue (white)
- Ruler Blank
- Cards – are available at craft suppliers in many sizes and colours.
- Toothpicks may be used for applying the glue
- Scissors – Small sharp embroidery scissors are very useful, especially when fringing paper strips for fringed flowers Tweezers – Sharp nosed are best. These are a great help when placing your prepared flowers or rolls onto your card.
- Work Board – piece of foam or cork board approximately 25 cm x 25 cm covered with cling wrap.
- Cotton Buds – for shaping bells etc.
- Plastic or silver foil is needed to place glue on ready for application of work
